WATCH FOR THE CLUB BEING USED WHEN ANOTHER GOLFER PLAYS HIS APPROACH AHEAD OF YOU. THEN PAY ATTENTION TO THE FLIGHT OF THE BALL, INCLUDING ITS BEHAVIOR ON LANDING. FINALLY, "GO TO SCHOOL" ON CHIPS AND PUTTS WHEN YOU'LL BE PLAYING ON A SIMILAR LINE.
