Avista Corp, Todd McLaughlin, PO Box 3727 MSC-21, Spokane, WA 99220-3727, is seeking coverage under the Washington State Department of Ecology's Construction Stormwater NPDES and State Waste Discharge General Permit.
The proposed project, Medical Lake-Cheney HP Natural Gas Upgrade, will begin near Lakeland Village in Medical Lake and continue southeast for approximately nine miles terminating in the City of Cheney near Eastern Washington University. The alignment traverses Sections 3, 4, 10 and 11, Township 23N, Range 41E; Sections 24 and 25 Township 24N, Range 40E; and Sections 29, 30, 32, 33 Township 24N, and Range 41E.
The project will primarily occur in existing easements located through private property and within road right-of-way in Medical Lake and Cheney, both in Spokane County.

This project involves 36 acres of soil disturbance for utility construction activities.
The receiving waterbodies are Clear Lake, Silver Lake, Unnamed Streams, Unnamed Wetlands, Big Swamp.
