The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service is seeking qualified bidders to commercially thin ponderosa pine on portions of three refuge management units within Turnbull National Wildlife Refuge, Cheney, WA. The purpose of this project is to reduce hazardous fuels and to improve forest health and wildlife habitat. The project will involve thinning stands of ponderosa pine with a leave tree marked prescription using whole tree skidding.
One unit is planned to be thinned between November 13, 2018 and February 22, 2019. The remaining two units are planned to be thinned between January 7, 2019 and April 15, 2019.
