**Section 2.** Uniform Allowance. A uniform allowance is provided certain employees to provide general identification of the person in carrying out the function of the department. Public Works employees who are members of Local 270-A, AFSCME, AFL-CIO shall be entitled to \$66.00 per month, or \$792.00 annually as uniform allowance. Police and Fire employees who are members of the Public Safety Guild and the Police Chief and Fire Chief shall be entitled to \$125.00 per month, or \$1,500.00 annually as uniform allowance. The Treatment Plant Operator III (Operational) and the City Engineer shall also be entitled to \$66.00 per month, or \$792.00 annually for uniform allowance. The Senior Building Inspector, Building Inspector, and the Community Engagement & Enforcement Officer shall also be entitled to \$66.00 per month, or \$792.00 annually for uniform allowance.

**Section 3.** Insurance. As part of the compensation for city employees the City of Airway Heights will provide the following to all full time employees: medical, dental, and vision insurance, an employee assistance program, a \$10,000.00 life insurance policy, a VEBA contribution and dependent medical and dental coverage as provided for in the Local 270 A and Public Safety Guild bargaining unit agreements and in Sections 5 and 6 of this ordinance for non-represented employees. For the Public Safety Guild, the City shall provide accounts for deferred compensation and will match the amount that the employee directs to be deducted from his/her monthly pay to go towards his/her deferred compensation up to a maximum of 6.2% monthly.

The City shall make payroll deduction available for Public Safety Guild members to purchase the group disability insurance plan which the Guild sponsors through WACOPS. The City will contribute \$82.05 per month, per employee, for this coverage.

**Section 4.** Additional Compensation. Occasionally, the Fire Chief may work as part of a Washington State Fire Service team involved in fighting fires or wildfires. The City will pay the Fire Chief for work time outside of his normal work hours while at a fire at a rate of 1.5 times his normal pay rate. The City will subsequently be reimbursed from the Washington State Patrol for the amount of wages and benefits expended.

**Section 5.** Non-Represented Employees (Other than City Manager and Department Heads). This group of employees is not represented by bargaining units and includes the positions of Assistant Clerk-Treasurer, Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator III, City Engineer, Parks & Recreation & Community Services Deputy Director, Parks & Facilities Maintenance Supervisor, Recreation Programs Supervisor, Guest Services & Operations Supervisor, Fitness Supervisor, and

Aquatics Supervisor. All nine positions receive a VEBA contribution of \$425.00 per month, per employee, and medical benefit coverage of \$1,373.00 per member, per month to be used to purchase medical benefits for the employee, spouse and/or dependents. Any amount unused will revert to the City.

**Section 6.** Non-Represented Employees (City Manager and Department Heads). This group of employees is not represented by bargaining units and includes the positions of City Manager, Police Chief, Fire Chief, Public Works Director, Parks, Recreation and Community Services Director, Development Services Director, Court Administrator, and Finance Director/Clerk-Treasurer. There is also provided a VEBA contribution of \$425.00 per month, per employee, and medical benefit coverage of \$1,373.00 per month, to be used to purchase medical benefits for the employee, spouse and/or dependents. Any amount unused will revert to the City.

**Section 7.** Employee Assistance Program. An Employee Assistance Program (EAP) is provided by the City through the AWC Insurance Benefit Trust to all employees covered under a Regence/Asuris or Group Health group medical plan. The Employee Assistance Program is a free, confidential resource for employees. The EAP includes counseling, including marital issues, legal assistance, financial assistance, and also includes online resources, onsite training, and critical incident debriefing. Dependents and everyone living in the employee's home can use the EAP free of charge. The EAP provides for one to three free visits per issue, with an EAP counselor, available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

**Section 8.** Public Retirement Systems - PERS and LEOFF. The City provides retirement benefits for eligible employees through the Public Employees Retirement System Plan 2 or 3 and through the Law Enforcement Officers and Fire Fighters Plan 2. If an employee has previously received a retirement allowance from any public retirement system authorized by the general laws of the State of Washington, they are not eligible for becoming a member of any system listed in RCW 41.50.030, which include PERS and LEOFF, provided that this does not apply to persons who have accumulated less than fifteen years service credit in any such system.

If an employee is ineligible for membership in the State of Washington's Public Employee Retirement System (PERS) Plan 2 or 3 or the Law Enforcement Officers and Fire Fighters (LEOFF) Plan 2 due to prior employment, the City may contribute to the State of Washington Deferred Compensation Program on behalf of the employee at the same percentage rate as authorized for the employer's contribution to PERS or LEOFF.

**Section 9.** Annual Pay Adjustment for Non-Represented Exempt City Employees. It is the intent of the City to provide annual cost of living adjustments to Non-Represented Exempt City employees, provided the resources are available for these compensation increases. The increases are intended to mirror any increases employees receive who are represented by the current bargaining groups known as 270A and the Airway Heights Public Safety Guild. Following collective bargaining and City Council approval of annual budget adjustments, the City Manager will recommend to the City Council a cost-of-living adjustment to be implemented for Non-Represented Exempt City employees which adjusts salary structures by an approved percentage or flat dollar amount.

**Section 10.** Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA). The City will contribute employer portion of FMLA premium; the employee will contribute the employee portion of the premium.

**Section 11.** Longevity Pay. The City will provide a longevity pay at the 10, 15, 20, and 30-year marks. The City will provide an annual amount of \$500 per year starting at year 10, provide an annual amount of \$750 per year starting at year 15, provide an annual amount of \$1,000 per year starting at year 20, and provide an annual amount of \$1,500 per year starting at year 30.

**Section 12.** Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance.

**Section 13.** Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication of this Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official newspaper of the City as provided by law.
