CODE TO EXEMPT AVISTA
AND INLAND POWER AND
LIGHT FROM THE

TAX FROM THE KALISPEL
AND SPOKANE TRIBES**

WHEREAS, the City of Airway Heights imposes a utility tax upon electric and gas companies, pursuant to RCW 35A.82.020; **WHEREAS,** the tax is six percent (6%) of the total gross operating revenue derived from sales imposed by businesses that provide electricity and electrical energy within the City, pursuant to AHMC 5.04.050(B); **WHEREAS,** the City also imposes a tax natural gas, which is equal to six percent (6%) of gross operating revenue from sales of such gas within the limits of the City, pursuant to AHMC 5.04.050(C); **WHEREAS,** both the Kalispel Tribe of Indians and the Spokane Tribe of Indians are sovereign nations with tribal property and members immune from local taxation, except as otherwise agreed or provided by law or treaty; and **WHEREAS,** an exemption to the payment and collection of the utility tax imposed pursuant to AHMC 5.04.050 should be established for the Kalispel Tribe and the Spokane Tribe to include eliminating the obligation of electric service companies and/or natural gas companies to collect said tax based upon gross operating revenues.

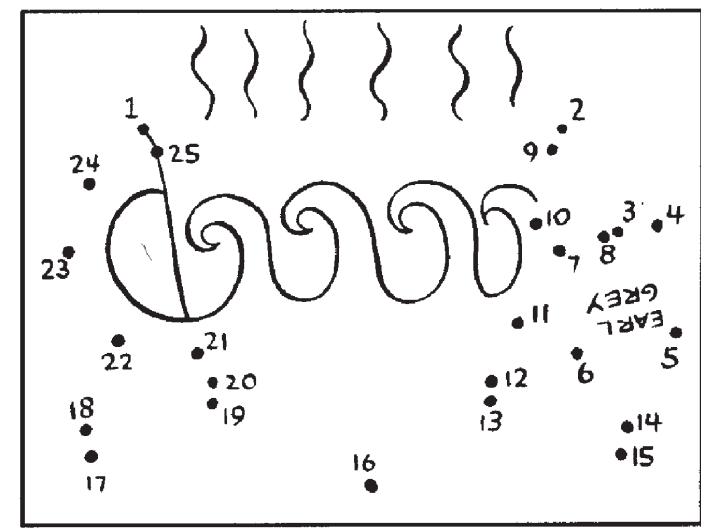

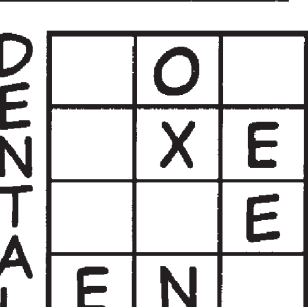
