WHEREAS, in conformity with the legal requirements, the Sprague City Council passed Resolution No. 2023-17 on August 30, 2023, setting a public hearing regarding this proposed vacation on September 27, 2023; and,
WHEREAS, in conformity with the legal requirements proper notice of the public hearing was posted and mailed to all required parties; and,
WHEREAS, on September 27, 2023, said public hearing was held before the Sprague City Council having only one public speaker and no objections to the proposed vacation; and,

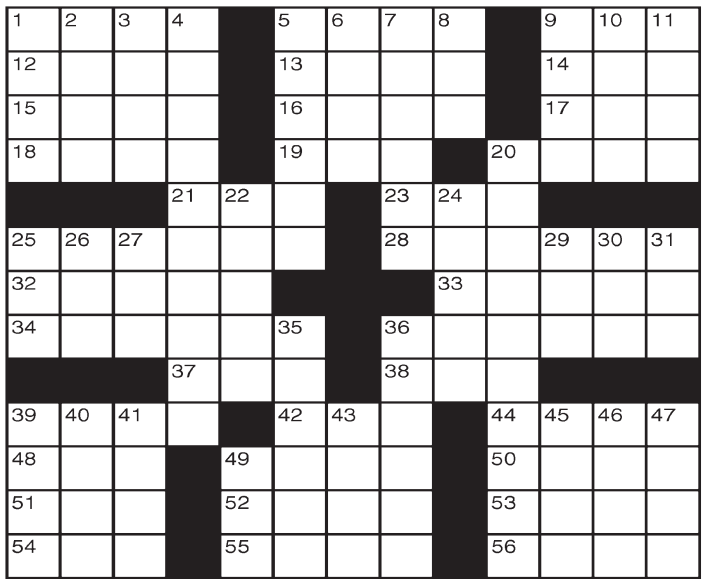

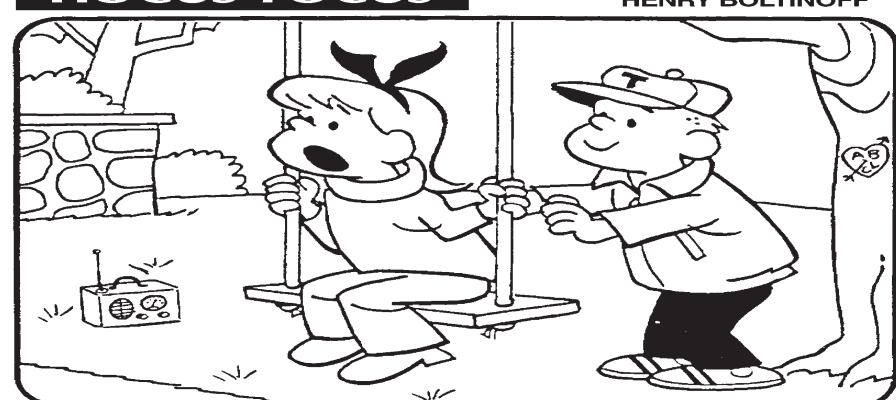

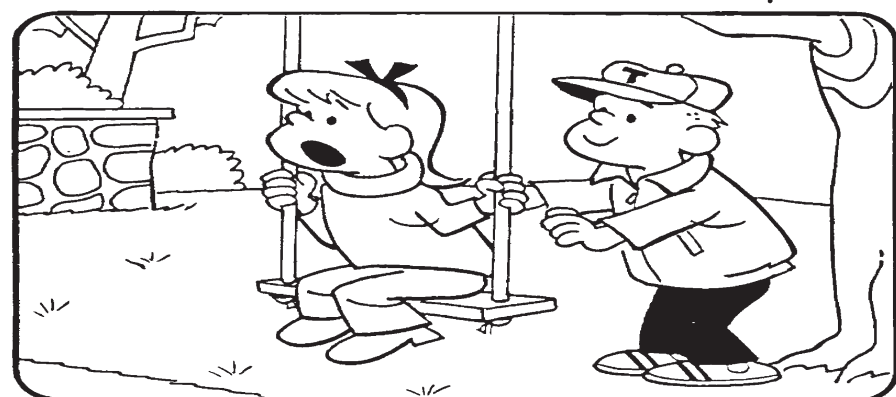
