Description of Work: This work is for the trenchless boring and installation of steel casing, ductile iron water transmission pipeline, and fiber optic duct under two sets of railroad tracks, and associated earthwork, environmental controls, and surface restoration of boring pits. The work is to be performed between December 2023 through August 2024.
