Section 1. Adoption of the Budget. The budget for the City of Medical Lake for the year 2023 is hereby adopted at the department level and as the balanced budget for the City with appropriations limited to the total estimated revenues and ending fund balance of the City. The final budget of \$11,479,128.55, attached hereto by this reference, is incorporated herein pursuant to RCW 35A.33.075. Estimated resources for each separate fund of the City of Medical Lake, and aggregate expenditures for all such funds for the year 2023 are set forth in a summary form in Exhibit A.
Section 2. Positions, Salary Schedules and Adjustments. The various positions and salary ranges for City employees are adopted in the form and amounts attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit B. To further the efficient operation of the City, the Mayor is authorized to make transfers between individual appropriations within any one fund for the 2023 budget. Any person having a claim against the Decedent must, before the time the claim would be barred by any otherwise applicable statute of limitations, present the claim in the manner as provided in RCW 11.40.070 by serving on or mailing to the Personal Representative or the Personal Representative's attorney at the address stated below a copy of the claim and filing the original of the claim with the court.

The claim must be presented within the later of: (a) thirty days after the Personal Representative served or mailed the notice to the creditor as provided under RCW 11.40.020(3); or (2) four months after the date of first publication of the notice.

If the claim is not presented within this time frame, the claim will be forever barred, except as otherwise provided in RCW 11.40.051 and RCW 11.40.060. This bar is effective as to claims against both the probate assets and nonprobate assets of the decedent.
