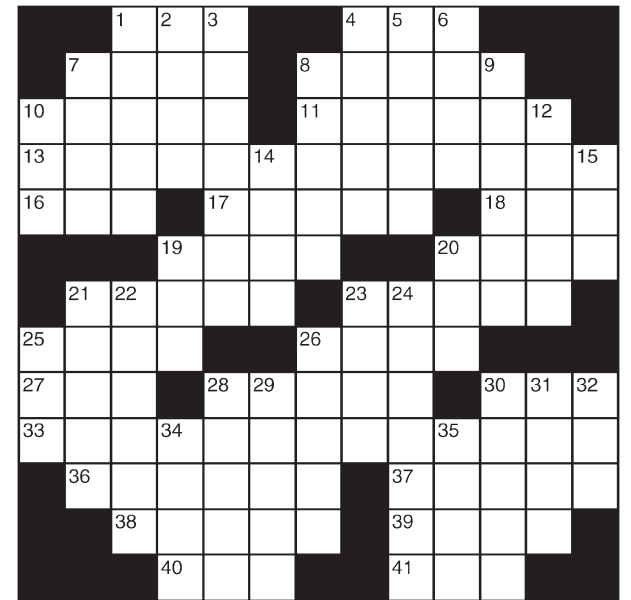

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The Garden Bug

This familiar herb is easy to grow and makes a nice garnish for soups and other dishes. It loves full sunlight and rich, well-drained soil. Plant seeds directly into the ground after all danger of frost has passed in spring, covering the seeds with about 1/8-inch of soil or fine sand. Keep the soil slightly moist until the seeds germinate; after that, water the plants well about once a week. Parsley is especially beneficial for attracting black swallowtails, anise swallowtail and other butterflies.
